NBD score - The Neurogenic Bowel Dysfunction score¹

Dear Colleague,

We are pleased to offer you a symptom-based tool, the Neurogenic Bowel Dysfunction (NBD) score, a validated questionnaire to assess the impact of colorectal symptoms on patients' quality of life.¹

The questionnaire could help identify those people who may benefit from using Peristeen® for transanal irrigation. The NBD score may also be useful to assess any change in the persons condition when tested 2–3 months after the initiation of irrigation. This in turn could improve patient adherence to treatment.

This questionnaire is simple and can be self-administered by individual patients. It contains 10 questions; giving a total score of between 0 and 47, corresponding to the severity of colorectal disorders. A score ≥10 corresponds to moderate to severe bowel dysfunction and would justify the use of Peristeen.
